On March 4, 2020, the Governor of the State of California declared a State of Emergency to exist in California by reason of the COVID-19 pandemic; and by Executive Order N-28-20 extended the 30-day prohibition against residential evictions during a declared State of Emergency contained in Penal Code § 396(f) to May 31, 2020, and

On May 29, 2020, the Governor of the State of California issued Executive Order N-28-20, which extends by an additional 60 days the prohibition contained in Penal Code § 396(f) to July 28, 2020, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Execution of any Writ of Possession for residential real property issued by this court after March 4, 2020, shall be suspended until after July 28, 2020;
2. Nothing in this Amendment to General Order 20-011 shall restrict the enforcement of move-out orders contained within restraining orders, domestic violence prevention orders, or elder abuse orders;
3. This amendment is effective as of May 29, 2020, nunc pro tunc.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
