The following order is effective December 14, 2020 through January 11, 2021:

Suspended and Continued Matters:

All jury trials with time waivers are suspended until January 11, 2021.

Any and all infraction (traffic) arraignments and trials will be continued for 60 days. Parties will be notified of the new dates.

All civil matters including case management conferences and settlement conferences will be continued for 60 days. Civil filings may occur but they will be filed as staffing allows. The documents shall be stamped as received to comply with any statutory issues.

All probate matters will be continued for 60 days. Probate filings may occur but they will be filed as staffing allows. The documents shall be stamped as received to comply with any statutory issues.

All family law matters including case management conferences and settlement conferences will be continued for 60 days. Family law filings may occur but they will be filed as staffing allows. The documents shall be stamped as received to comply with any statutory issues.

All child support matters will be continued for 60 days. Parties will be notified of the new dates. Child support filings may occur but they will be filed as staffing allows. The documents shall be stamped as received to comply with any statutory issues.

Matters Being Filed, Expedited and Heard:

The following matters will be filed and expedited and heard: Criminal matters, No Time Waiver jury trials, Dependency matters, Delinquency matters, LPS Conservatorships, Unlawful Detainers, Emergency Family Law matters, Domestic Violence Restraining Orders, or Restraining Orders.

All filings will be dropped off between the hours of 9:00am and 3:00pm in the filing box located at the bailiffs' station inside the front door of the courthouse and will be checked by staff every half hour. Public access to the courthouse will be closed as of 3:00pm except if a matter is being heard.

In order to protect the health and safety of the public, including court users, personnel, judicial officers, and others, all judicial proceedings are encouraged to be conducted remotely by either video or telephonic means.
