DRESS CODE POLICY

All persons who appear in any courtroom shall wear appropriate attire. The bailiff on duty, under the supervision of the judge presiding in that courtroom has the authority to enforce this rule and exclude persons with inappropriate attire from entering the courtroom. "Appropriate attire" means clothing consistent with the seriousness and dignity of the judicial process. As a minimum standard the Court requires:

- Shirts must be buttoned.
- Undergarments shall not be visible.
- Shoes shall be worn at all times.
- No bare midriffs, pants that fall below the hips, halter tops, cut offs, tank tops, undershirts, see-through or overly revealing blouses, bathing suits, lingerie, athletic uniforms, hats, sunglasses, or clothing emblazoned with obscene words or gang slogans.

Images or messages contemptuous or disrespectful of the judicial system detract from the dignity of the judicial process and are prohibited.
