9 On March 4, 2020, the Governor of the State of California declared a State of Emergency
10 to exist in California by reason of the COVID-19 pandemic; and by Executive Order N-28-20
11 extended the 30-day prohibition against residential evictions during a declared State of
12 Emergency contained in Penal Code § 396(f) to May 31, 2020, and

13 On March 27, 2020, the Governor of the State of California issued Executive Order
14 N-37-20, which extended by 60 days the deadlines specified in Code of Civil Procedure section
15 1167, and further ordered that no writ of possession may be enforced in evictions where a tenant
16 satisfied the requirements of subparagraphs (a) – (c) of paragraph 1 for the period when
17 Executive Order N-37-20 was in effect, and

18 Executive Order N-37-20 remained in effect through May 31, 2020 and has not been
19 extended by further Executive Order of the Governor. Therefore, good cause appearing,
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21 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

- 23 1. General Order 20-016, which temporarily halted the issuance of writs of possession
- 24 through July 28, 2020, concurrent with the Governor’s Executive Orders N-28-20 and
- 25 N-66-20, is hereby rescinded.

- 27 2. This order is effective as of May 31, 2020, nunc pro tunc.
